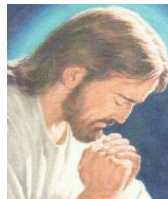
**Continuation** of the reflection:

Through these words, Jesus was saying: Let those who are spiritually dead bury those who are physically dead. My message is one of life. Jesus was fully aware of the respect children had towards their parents, especially when it concerned burying one's parents. This filial piety was deeply rooted in Judaism. But in His response, Jesus did not intend to be taken literally. Rather, He wanted to stir the thoughts of those who were present.

To the other who said that He would follow Jesus after saying farewell to those at home, Jesus said, **"No one who puts a hand to the plough and looks back is fit for the kingdom of God,"** (Lk 9:61-2). In other words, true discipleship (symbolized here by ploughing) demands more than what was demanded of Elisha (1 Kgs 19:19-21). To plough for the Kingdom of God, it demands sacrifice. If one takes the time to look back, one interrupts the task or is distracted, and the work of God may suffer.

Brothers and sisters, this is God's message to us. In true discipleship, there is no turning back. There is no turning back to worldly ways. As slaves of Christ, we are expected to continuously move forward, growing in our spiritual lives by the grace of God the Father and the sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit, in the most holy name of Jesus.

*(REFLECTION: How have I lived my life in relation to the need to share in the life of Christ? Is there any unforgiveness, anger, resentments in my heart that I need to resolve, and how do I intend to resolve this spirit of unforgiveness in me? Am I committed to a life of discipleship through which I may be sanctified and justified?)*
